This new proration method prorates at the charge-folder level (instead of at the visit level as with previous versions), which can more accurately determine expected reimbursement for each claim on a visit and associate the expected reimbursement calculations to the appropriate charge folder. This type of proration is especially useful in situations where there are multiple charge folders on a single visit.
